In 1938, George McKay began working for Bursley & Co., which later merged to form Food Marketing Corporation. He became President and C.E.O. of Food Marketing in 1958. The company merged into SuperValue Stores, Inc., the largest wholesale grocery business in the country with \$400 million in gross sales.

McKay then moved to Minneapolis to become SuperValu Stores' President and C.E.O. Since his retirement in 1979, McKay returned to Fort Wayne. As a hobby, he has a financial interest in four new Cub Grocery Stores in Indianapolis, Indiana, and in Toledo, Ohio.
