

Kenneth W. Maxfield



Kenneth Maxfield started his career with North American Van Lines (NAVL) on November 1, 1950, after graduating from DePaul University with a law degree. Pepsico bought out NAVL in June of 1969. In 1977, Maxfield was named President. Maxfield increased profit seven times; from seven million dollars to fifty million dollars during his tenure. He took the volume from 250 million to over one billion a year.

Maxfield sold NAVL to Norfolk Southern Railroads in 1985 for 369 million dollars. After spending 39 years with NAVL, Maxfield retired in 1989 and now spends his time working for many of Fort Wayne's community organizations.
