SOCIAL SECURITY:

A social insurance system that provides benefits to most Americans who are retired, sick, or too disabled to work, and to families of workers who have died.







MEDICARE: A social insurance program that extends health coverage to almost all Americans age 65 and over.



ncome Tax Uses




Property Tax Uses

Paycheck Vocabulary

GROSS ANNUAL INCOME (GAI): Total pay or earnings made over a one-year period before any deductions have been taken.

GROSS MONTHLY INCOME (GMI): Total amount of earnings made over a month before any deductions (1/12 of GAI).

NET ANNUAL INCOME (NAI): Income amount remaining after a year's worth of deductions have been taken.

NET MONTHLY INCOME (NMI): Amount of monthly income remaining after all deductions have been taken (sometimes referred to as take-home pay).

GAI \$56,000

GMI \$56,000 divided by 12 =
