Participation Agreement

To ensure a valuable experience for all participants, JA BizTown can accommodate between 70 and 100 students, and will partner together no more than 5 groups for a single simulation visit.

- Each group is required to have a minimum of 12 (preferably 15+) participating students in 4th–6th grade.
- The JA BizTown lessons and activities incorporate teamwork, and should therefore be taught to the group as a whole; not by each individual family. Each group will receive one set of teacher materials (curriculum guide & classroom kit). Additional materials may be distributed at JA’s discretion.
- JA will assign groups to simulation dates on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Each group will be responsible for recruiting 1 parent volunteer per business assigned to your group. On average, groups are assigned 1 business for every 5 students.

Junior Achievement will provide the following:

- One five-hour visit to JA BizTown.
- Training sessions and materials for teachers and volunteers.
- Classroom instructional materials for students and teachers.
- Materials for use during the on-site visit.
- Unlimited consultation.

Participating teachers agree to:

- Attend the appropriate teacher training session (new or returning) at the JA BizTown facility.
- Spend sufficient time to complete 13 core lessons (including 1 after your visit) along with additional simulation preparation activities.
- Arrange for student transportation & ensure all students bring lunch with them.
- Recruit adult volunteers who will complete mandatory training (either at the JA facility or online) prior to your visit, and join you for the full five-hour visit to JA BizTown.
- Pay a participation fee of \$20/student. Refunds will not be made for students who participate in the classroom instruction but are unable to attend the on-site simulation visit. Fees are due 10 days prior to your visit, and groups are held liable for all fees if cancellation occurs less than 60 days prior to the visit.
