Competition Rules:

Competition is broken in to several age levels for baseball and softball:

Division A (9-10 years)

Division B (11-12 years)

Division C (13-14 years)

Division D (15-16 years)

Division E (17-18 years)

There will be three rounds of competition for each Division. The top four scores from Round 1 advance to Round 2, the top two scores from Round 2 advance to Championship Round. Points will not be carried over from Round to Round. Batters receive one practice swing before first competition swing, and are allowed 9 outs per Round. Batters must provide their own pitcher. A trophy will be awarded to the top finisher for each Division in Round 3. Round 3 winners will receive a trophy and a family pass for the 2020 MTSU Baseball season.

Scoring:

Foul ball=0 points

Swing and miss= 0 points

Homerun=1 point

9 outs per round. If in Round 3, batter hits a homerun on the 9th out, 2 points will awarded instead of 1.

Tie Breaker:

1st tie breaker- 5 swings

2nd tie breaker- 3 swings

3rd tie breaker - Farthest hit ball marked by a judge

Rules:

- All batters must wear a helmet.
- Cleats are allowed.
- Batters must provide their own pitcher.
- Batters do not have to swing at every pitch.
- Any out is a swing that does not result in a homerun.
- All batters must supply their own bats.
- Profanity and excessive arguing will not be tolerated from any player or parent and is subject to disqualification without reimbursement. This is a fun event and let's keep it that way.
- This event is not affiliated with the MLB Jr. Derby.
