- JA program led by a live virtual volunteer or virtual educator.
- All JA activities have been adapted for students to be able to do with materials at home or in the classroom.
- Live educator or volunteer utilizes a pre-made slide deck with embedded videos and worksheets.
- To supplement the educator-led program, a virtual JA volunteer can join as a subject matter expert.

## Volunteer Led Pre-Recorded

- JA program led by a pre-recorded virtual volunteer.
- JA program includes a slide deck with embedded videos, activities and worksheets that students can do at home or in the classroom.
