



KPLR 11 Meteorologist

You are responsible for writing weather reports, reading the weather report on-air, and giving a weather/science interview on-air.

DURING BUSINESS START-UP, COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING.

1. Remain in your business until the Opening Town Meeting to help with business set-up. Your business needs everyone's help before it opens.
2. Review the directions on how to use the remote weather station. You will give on-air weather reports throughout the day.
3. Prepare the **Meteorologist First Weather Report** using the instruction sheet in your manual and the KPLR 11 weather web page.

DURING THE FIRST WORK/BREAK ROTATION (AFTER THE NATIONAL ANTHEM) COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING.

1. At the beginning of the first break, write a weather report using the information from the remote weather station and a copy of the **Current Weather Report** worksheet. Instructions are in your manual.
2. Write a short description of Safety Tips in case of emergencies; i.e. tornado/ severe weather and fire. Be prepared to read your Safety Tips on-air.
3. You will broadcast the weather report **and** the Safety Tips during the first yellow break. You will also broadcast a weather report during the first green break.
4. Read the directions on how to present "Cloud-in-a-Bottle" experiment for your interview during the second green break. Practice reading your **TV Interview Sheet**.

DURING THE SECOND WORK/BREAK ROTATION

1. You will give a weather report during the yellow and green breaks.
2. Practice the "Cloud-in-a-Bottle" experiment a couple of times and your interview script. Give a weather report and demonstrate the experiment in your on-air interview during the second green break.
3. Assist with business clean-up at the end of the day. Recycle all used paper into the **blue** recycle bin.
